**Important:** Please see the “General Regulations and Entry Specification” section in the beginning of this omnibus for additional policies that this show subscribes to and follows.

**Class Fees:**

- A. Group, hunter, Warm up, Equitation O/F, Lead Line and in-hand: \$10 per class
- B. Medal, Mini Prix, Gambler or Introductory Level: \$15
- C. Training, First Level, all Western Dressage or Vintage Percentile: \$18.00
- D. Second Level or above: \$20.00

**Camper or RV:**

\$20 per night for camper hook-ups. \$10 per night for tent camping. Please pick up a permit in the show office at check-in.

**Office Charge:**

\$15 per horse and rider combination.

**Non-member Fee:**

All show entrants who are not members of NWDA must pay a \$15.00 non-member fee.

**Payment:**

Entries accepted by mail and must be accompanied by payment in the form of check or money order. No entries will be accepted until payment in full is received. Sorry, no credit cards are accepted. Fax or email entries will be accepted only on receipt of original entry and accompanying payment by mail.

**Late Entries:**

\$20 late fee for dressage entries post-marked or hand-delivered after the closing date. Classes may be added or changed as scheduling allows with a post-entry fee of \$5.00 per class. Horse/Rider change fee of \$20.00 after closing date.

**Concessions:**

Food delivery from local vendor available from 10:00 AM-4 :00 PM. Snacks on grounds during show hours.

**Stabling/Tack:**

\$50 for weekend stall from Fri-Sun; All horses must be stabled. \$30 for a weekend tack stall; \$25 per calendar day for either a horse or a tack stall. Horses allowed on grounds after 3:00pm on Friday, September 14, 2012. Competitors must pay a \$25.00 deposit per stall; your deposit will be returned to you at check-out if your stall is clean.

**Bedding:**

No bedding provided. Bags may be ordered on the entry form or from the show office while supplies last for \$8/bag. Special stabling requests filled on a first come, first serve basis. No paper bedding allowed.

**Non-compete horses:**

Horses on grounds that aren't competing in classes must have an entry form, current coggins, and pay for a stall

**Other:**

All pets on show grounds must be leashed at all times. **All entries must include copy of coggins test from the current calendar year, which must be on record with show office prior to unloading of horse on show grounds. \$20 charge for returned checks.**

### **Class Definitions:**

#### **Green Rider:**

Open to riders who have never placed in a dressage competition above training level or eventing, hunter or jumper competition above 2’3”.

#### **Gambler’s Choice:**

Choose your own course over fences to earn points assigned to each fence. Highest point count wins.

#### **Equitation Medal:**

Over-fences hunt seat equitation class following the specifications of the USA Hunter Seat Medal Class.

#### **Mini Prix:**

Jumper class in two rounds, fences to be raised in second round. First round clean qualifies for Second round jump-off, fastest clean time to win.

#### **Warm Ups**

For the Warm Up A and B- This card will be open all day, judged as one class, but riders will ride their warm up before their respective height, so they should specify which height they want to warm up with.

#### **Western Dressage:**

Dressage tests can be found on the IPHDA Web Site. Western saddle; bridle with snaffle rein required (pelhams and kimberwicks or similar bits allowed, no strictly curb bits, please)

#### **Lead Line:**

Open to children age 10 or under who are not riding in another class.

#### **Driving Dressage:**

Tests can be found on the American Driving Society web site
