- Freestyle rides please specify level and include copy of qualifying test.
- Opportunity Classes are for entry level riders; cross entry w/Intro classes is allowed. Horses and riders participating only in Opportunity Classes are exempt from USEF and USDF membership/ non-member fees, drug fee and Horse Identification (HID) requirements. If horse or rider does have HID or membership numbers, they must be listed on the entry form.

GAIG/USDF Qualifying: add \$10.00 to entry fee for each qualifying test and include copies of horse's USDF & USEF registrations. USDF/USEF Cards for incomplete entries will be printed for fee of \$10.00.

All entries that are submitted by mail, must be accompanied by a check or money order. Draw checks to "NWDA." Returned check fee of \$20.

Credit cards will be accepted via the www.equestrianentries.com website.

Refunds: Full refund less office fees available prior to closing date. After closing date, other than USEF/USDF fees, are non refundable for any reason, including acts of God.

Late Entries: \$35.00 if not postmarked or submitted online by closing date, if scheduling allows. Entries will not be accepted without payment. Class adds/changes after closing date only if scheduling allows, for a fee of \$5.00 per add/change. Change of horse or rider after closing date is \$20.00.

Stabling/Tack Fees: \$75.00 from Friday to Sunday per horse. \$60.00 for weekend tack stalls. \$40.00 per day or portion thereof for either horse or tack stall. \$25.00 stall cleaning deposit (Separate check, which will be returned at end of show, if stall is cleaned). Permanent and temporary stalls with doors are on the show grounds. No bedding provided, you can bring your own, or shavings may be ordered on entry for \$8 per bag or purchased at the show while supplies last. Please indicate stallions and special requests on the entry form. Some stalls may be 8'x8'-please indicate on entry if larger stall is required. All horses must be stabled; no jump-outs.

Stabling is available after 3pm the day before the show.
Special requests honored on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Non-compete/Schooling Fee: \$20.00 per calendar day for horses on grounds and not competing. Must submit entry form and coggins, and pay office fee and stabling.

Ride times: Preliminary ride times will be **emailed**, no later than Wednesday, June 6th, 2012. Final ride times will be posted on show grounds 24 hours prior to start of competition. Riders are responsible for informing management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving preliminary times.

Footing: All classes will be held in outdoor rings with sand footing. Warm-up areas are sand footing or grass over sand.

Awards: Ribbons to 6th place. Classes may be split by division (JR/YR, AA & Open) if entries warrant.

Accommodations: Lumbermen's Inn (Iron River): 715-372-4515, The Red Motel (Iron River): 715-372-8770, Rustic Roost (Iron River): 715-372-4426, Brule River Motel (Brule): 715-372-4817.

Directions: I-35 North to Highway 2 East (exit 253A). Cross bay into Superior, WI. Turn left at stoplight. Follow Highway 2 (Belknap St) to Barker's Island. Turn right at junction of Highways 2 and 53. Follow Highways 2/53 out of Superior. Hwy 53 will split off to the right/South. Take Hwy 2, the LEFT split and continue to follow Hwy 2 through Wentworth, Poplar, and Brule. Before the Town of Iron River, there is a lake on the right and a sign on the right hand side of the road that says, "Fairgrounds." Turn left and follow to fairgrounds, approx. ¾ mile.

Other: All dogs must be leashed. No smoking in stall areas, show office or other buildings. Snacks and beverages will be available on the show grounds. Meal delivery available at the show office from local restaurants.
