Important: Please see the “General Regulations and Entry Specification” section in the beginning of this omnibus for additional policies that this show subscribes to and follows.

- Class Fees:** A. Group, hunter and in-hand: \$10 per class or \$25 per division (for hunter only)
B. Jumper, Medal, Western Dressage or Introductory Level: \$15
C. Training or First Level: \$18.00
D. Second Level or above: \$20.00
F. All Championship classes: Add \$5.00 to class fees above. Please include copy of qualifying test (see class list).
- Camper or RV:** \$20 per night for camper hook-ups. \$10 per night for tent camping. Please pick up a permit in the show office at check-in.
- Office Charge:** \$10 per horse and rider combination.
- Non-member Fee:** All show entrants who are not members of NWDA must pay a \$15 non-member fee.
- Payment:** Entries accepted by mail and must be accompanied by payment in the form of check or money order. No entries will be accepted until payment in full is received. Sorry, no credit cards are accepted. Fax or email entries will be accepted only on receipt of original entry and accompanying payment by mail.
- Late Entries:** \$20 late fee for dressage entries post-marked after the closing date. Classes may be added or changed as scheduling allows with a post-entry fee of \$5.00 per class after the closing date. Horse/Rider change fee of \$20.00 after closing date.
- Concessions:** Concession stand available on grounds during lunch hours.
- Stabling/Tack:** \$50 for stall from Fri-Sun; \$30 for stall from Sat-Sun per horse. All horses must be stabled. \$30 for a weekend tack stall; \$25 per day for either a horse or a tack stall. Stall days are 24 hour periods defined as follows: 3 PM Fri - 3 PM Sat or 3 PM Sat - 3 PM Sun. Horses allowed on grounds after 12 noon on Friday, September 10, 2010. No jump outs.
- Bedding:** No bedding provided. Bags may be ordered on the entry form or from the show office while supplies last for \$7/bag. Special stabling requests filled on a first come, first serve basis. No paper bedding allowed.
- Please Note:** Horses on grounds that aren't competing in classes must have an entry form, current coggins, and pay a stall and \$20.00 non-compete fee.
- Other:** All pets on show grounds must be leashed at all times. **All entries must include copy of current coggins test, which must be on record with show office prior to unloading of horse on show grounds. \$20.00 charge for returned checks.**
- Awards:** Ribbons through 6th place and for all classes. Table II distribution for Pay-back classes. Trophies and/or prize awards for 1st place. High points to be awarded by division each day.

Class Definitions:

Green Rider:

Open to riders who have never placed in a dressage competition above training level or eventing, hunter or jumper competition above 2'3".

Dressage Seat Medal:

Group dressage equitation class following the class specifications of the USDF dressage seat medal. See www.usdf.org for more information.

Equitation Medal:

Over-fences hunt seat equitation class following the specifications of the USA Hunter Seat Medal Class. See <http://www.usef.org/documents/hunterJumper/hunter-seat-manual-2002.pdf> for more information.

Gambler's Choice:

Choose your own course over fences to earn points assigned to each fence. Highest point count wins.

Mini Prix:

Jumper class in two rounds, fences to be raised in second round. First round clean qualifies for Second round jump-off, fastest clean time to win.

Western Tack Dressage*:

Dressage class test of choice to be ridden in Western Tack with snaffle rein required (pelhams and kimberwicks or similar bits allowed, no strictly curb bits, please).

Vintage:

Open to riders over the age of 50.

Combined Test of Choice:

Choose one dressage and one over-fences class for combined scoring. Jumping faults subtract from dressage score.

Please indicate on entry form which two classes to use for combined entry. Limit one entry per horse/rider combo.

**:

Twin Ports Hunter-Jumper Circuit members may accrue points in these classes towards TPHJC awards.

Championship Classes:

Please include copy of any 2009 test from any recognized or schooling dressage show with qualifying score as follows: Intro, Training and First Level: 60% or greater. 2nd Level and above: 58% or greater. **NOTE: MUST BE AN NWDA MEMBER TO ENTER CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES**
